Where will Youth Encounter be held on Campus & What Happens There?

Youth Encounter will take place in the Bishop McManus Academy Sports Complex located directly behind the City Church Sanctuary.

Activities:

- **KREWE GAMES:** Krewe Games is a competition we do to promote unity and friendship while at encounter! We break off each student into a "krewe" that is designated by color, and we have different competitions that bring each team points. Whatever team wins by the end of encounter, wins a trophy and has a big celebration.
- **Free Time:** During this time students can utilize the sports equipment. These activities include, basketball, volleyball, football, card games, and more. Each activity will be supervised with a leader/leaders to ensure a safe and fun environment.
- Sessions: Sessions are our services that we have for encounter. We sometimes break off into girl/guy sessions as well to focus on things in a more personal way. Our sessions are held in the Sports Complex.

What to Bring & What Not to Bring?

It's our goal to help be fully prepared for Youth Encounter. Here is a list of items we DO NOT allow. <u>We also ask that all students be dress modestly</u>: *Nothing tight, see-through, or revealing, no crop tops allowed. Shorts must be fingertip length or longer.*

How Do I Get in Touch with My Student During Encounter?

All students will need to leave their phone and any other electronic devices at home for Youth Encounter. Anyone who brings their phone to the Encounter will be required to surrender it at registration, and we will hold it for the duration of day; it will be returned at the end of the Encounter. We do this to allow students a chance to step away from what's going on in the world and remove distractions while they seek after God and build new friendships.
